Dear Parents & Carers,

I would like to thank you all for your support this week in helping us re-open the school for all pupils. Staff have had a fantastic “Belonging” themed week with the children and everyone is really pleased to be back together again.

I am also pleased to report that there is now a much smoother drop-off and collection routine established outside on the pavement each day. Moving Year 5 to another gate has been the solution. If any parents have any further concerns, please do come and speak with me outside in the mornings or after school.

PE starts next week and children need to wear their PE kit on a PE day.

As of next week (due to the current situation), children will need to come in to school wearing PE kit on their PE days. ***They do not have to wear their school uniform on a PE day, only their PE kit all day.*** Many other schools have adopted this approach in order to comply with government guidance.

PE Kit:

- Oak Hill House coloured polo shirt
- Green or black jogging bottoms
- Green or black hoodie or track suit with no logos or branding
- Black plimsolls or trainers

Each year group has different PE days. Your child will also need to wear their PE kit on their Specialism Day every other week. Your child’s Team Leader will inform the class on which days children need to wear their PE kit in their weekly Friday email to parents.

- Please check your email tonight to see which days your child will have to wear their PE kit each week.

Road Safety

We kindly ask parents who drive cars to school to not park on the zig-zag lines on the road outside of the school as it is illegal to do so. Also, please do not park your car on the kerb where other parents need to walk; it is making it dangerous for us all. I appreciate the congestion outside of the school but there is a need for improved safety measures. School staff have been taking down number plates of offending cars and have forwarded them to the highways team.
