

Year 4 Homework- Spring Term 1


Time Cop: Historical Detectives

For the Enrichment Project homework this term, you will be creating a project entitled **Time Cop: Historical Detectives**.

There will be 3 exciting tasks to complete. This homework will help you with English and History lessons in school and will also inspire you to be as creative as possible with your learning.

There will be 3 prizes given out for the following categories:
1) Self- Worth 2) Engagement 3) Purpose

Task 1: Create a historical timeline, spanning over 100 years, of anything that interests you most, noting any key events, significant heroes or interesting facts. You could create a timeline of a football club, a genre of music, a place/location, a historical period, a religion, your family, a brand (e.g. Disney!)...anything! We will be sticking them up in the corridor and using them as learning tools so please can they be on paper or card. Rolls of backing paper/wall paper/wrapping paper has worked well in the past!

Task 2: Thinking about the Greeks and Romans, your task is to make a 3D historical object! You could design and make your own: shield, sword, helmet, piece of jewellery, mosaic or building. You could even design and make a model of a mythical creature....or design your own mythical creature!

Task 3: Your task is to make a fact file!

You can choose a significant figure from the Greek or Roman times (a famous Olympian, Scientist, hero, philosopher, etc.) or a theme from the Greeks or Romans (food, clothing, art, sport, battles, slaves, punishment, music) that interests you the most! How you present your fact file is up to you! You may want to do a leaflet or poster, or perhaps a PowerPoint presentation?
