For homework this term, you will be creating a project entitled ***SAXON SETTLERS AND VICIOUS VIKINGS*** How you create your project is up to you, but your teacher and your parents will help you with ideas.

There will be 3 tasks to complete. This homework will help you with History and English lessons in school and allow you to share the extra information with your class!

There will be 3 awards given out for the following categories:

1) Self-Worth

2) Engagement

3) Purpose

Task 1: Due in Wednesday 19th January

Your task is to make a sculpture (large 3D object) of either an Anglo-Saxon or a Viking object. It can be based on anything that has inspired you from that period of history (portrait of a king, armour, Saxon village, map of the Anglo-Saxon Kingdom, Viking longboat... the list is endless!)

CHALLENGE: Have a look at the picture, this sculpture of a bear was made from recycled materials. What type of material will you use for your sculpture?



Task 2: Due in Wednesday 26th January

Your task is to create an exciting fact file all about the Anglo-Saxon's or Viking's culture presented in any way you choose (e.g. poster, video, booklet, Power-Point Etc.!) You could include information on different significant people, Anglo-Saxon or Viking daily life, clothing, food and culture. We will display these in our learning areas and the corridor!

Task 3: Due in Wednesday 9th February

Your task is to create an **in-depth study** of a particular topic related to the Anglo-Saxons or Vikings that interests you the most (e.g. A particular famous Anglo-Saxon/ Viking and their importance in history, a particular significant person at the time, major events, a piece of artwork or sculpture, a particular building etc.). You can display your findings any way you choose (poster, PowerPoint, leaflet, song, booklet, 3D model etc.)!
