The children will take have an in-depth study into what leisure and entertainment was like during the <i>1990s and will make comparisons in regards to their life today</i>. We will then apply our understanding of the 1990s to our Final Product and Showcase whereby we will put together a <i>wonderful production of Romeo and Juliet with a 90s spin!</i> The children will have the opportunity to sing and act one of Shakespeare's finest work. The children will immerse themselves into an all singing, all dancing production and we look forward to welcoming you all to come and watch it- you do not want to miss it!</p>
