2) Purpose

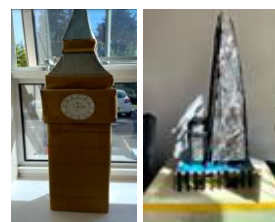
3) Engagement

e.g.

- The Elizabeth Tower out of cardboard
- The London Eye from a bike wheel
- The Shard out of cardboard covered in aluminium foil



When your projects are complete, bring them into school so we can show them off in the Year 3 corridor!

Task 2: To be handed in on Wednesday 4th October 2023

For your second homework instalment, you need to research a **river** or **mountain range** that is found in the **UK** and create an interesting fact file.

You can complete your research using the internet or a book from the library.

You need to then create a poster, fact file, poem or leaflet or information text.

Your information could be organised into:

- Paragraphs using sub-headings
- Fun Facts you didn't know
- Draw a picture of the river or mountain range



Task 3: To be handed in on Wednesday 11th October 2023

For your final homework instalment, will be writing a post card to a family member from your favourite place you have been to or researched in the UK.

You can write about:

- A visit to the seaside
- A visit to a country in the UK
- A trip to a UK city
